When New Zealand designer Greg Elliott sits down to design a record breaker you know the result will be innovative and exciting.

The launch last month of the Elliott Marine 50' (16m) project boat proved to be all that – and more.

Greg's aim was to design and build an ultra light 50 footer (16m) to take on records for short handed and fully crewed passage races with an eye firmly on the Melbourne-Osaka short handed race which starts in March 1995.

The result is a radical composite schooner, rigged with fully rotating carbon wing masts, all Kevlar rigging, all designed with an emphasis on reducing drag. Hull form and foil profiles continue this philosophy of drag reduction and incorporates a retractable Canard foil to balance the high-tech rig and ensures upwind as well as off the breeze performance.

While the latest advanced technologies and material have been used, the philosophy of efficiency has been extended to cover all aspects of the construction and fitout. To use Greg's words "everything on this boat has had to earn its place – there's no room for compromise". Not surprisingly, the complete fitout is by Ronstan. Owned by high profile New Zealand yachtsmen Tom McCall and Brian Petersen, the boat is currently undergoing sea trials in Auckland's Waitamata Harbour.





Our USA operation, Ronstan Marine Inc., has just completed its second full year of trading and Alistair Murray, Chief Executive for the USA/Canada operations, reports above budget sales for North America and continued strong growth in Canada.

It is no secret that the Ronstan C-Cleat has played a key role in securing increased market share and opened the doors to other Ronstan products. Calibrated Sealoc turnbuckles released last year are showing an exciting growth rate, with these products fitted as standard on popular USA boats such as the Melges 24 and the Johnson 18.

Ronstan 'Micro' SERIES 19 block sales have

increased dramatically. They are now recognised as the strongest, smallest and lowest friction block available on the market. We boast a minimum breaking load of 550kg (12101b) which, by the way, is for the single. The triple has a breaking load of 850kg (18701b).

While Ronstan Marine Inc. continues to exhibit at Boat and Trade Shows throughout the USA and Canada, additional emphasis has been placed this past year on high profile sponsorships. Ronstan continues to support America's champions of the future through the Inter Collegiate Yacht Racing Association. Ronstan enjoys a high profile with over 5,000 college sailors who sail at Regattas all year round.

Other notable high profile sponsorships include the NOOD (National Offshore One Design) Regatta Series and the Ronstan MUMM 36 East Coast Championships, both of which attracted top level talent and media exposure.

Manufacturing Manager, Mr Graeme Bond, accepted the award on behalf of Ronstan from the Acting Premier and Minister for Industry and Employment, The Hon. Phillip Gude, M.P.


The one hundred guests at the presentation luncheon held at

Parliament House were told of the transformation of Ronstan since the change of ownership in 1991 and how exports in general play a vital role in the company's success. Mr Bond acknowledged that for every exporter there is an importer at the other end to receive the goods and cited Ronstan's U.K. distributor, Bainbridge Aquabatten, as an example of a company who

increased purchases from Ronstan by a factor of 12 in the last three years.

The New South Wales and National awards were won by Bashford Boat Builders, with the Tasmanian State Award being given to Incat, builder of wavepiercing catamarans. Both companies are customers of Ronstan.


